Our Grade 3s have been working hard all year and are excited to share their learning with you. We have worked together to select a few pieces of work to highlight the work your child is most proud of. Your child will be bringing this work home to share with you for at-home student-led conferences. As a family, please spend some time reflecting on your child's work at home.

Student Guided Reflection

In class, your child has chosen key pieces of work to highlight what they are proud of, found engaging, or learned the most from. This work will be sent home in a portfolio collection. Some of the work may stay home, as we have finished the units, other work (such as work within writing or math journals) should be returned so that your child may continue to use the journals for the remainder of the school year. As you look through each piece, ask your child to share a little bit about the work.

Here are some example questions you might ask:

1. Can you read what you wrote to me?
2. What inspired you to write this story?
3. Tell me how you know the answer.
4. What are you most proud of in this piece?
5. What would you like to learn more about?
6. What are you working on now?
7. Can you tell me more about...?



2 Stars: What are two things that you are proud of in your child's work? Write the comments on the attached form.

Suggested sentence starters for the **2 stars:**

1. It makes me proud to see that...
2. I can tell you improved in...

What are some ways that you can encourage these strengths at home?



1 Wish: What is one area of your child's learning where you would like to see more growth? Focusing on a growth mindset, write a comment on the attached form.

Suggested sentence starters for the **1 wish:**

1. I would like to see you try ...
2. I will help you practice ...
