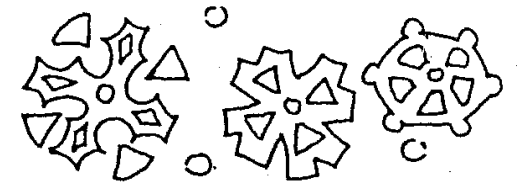







Division 21's January Calendar
