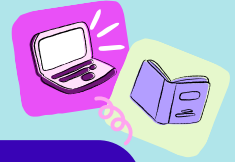
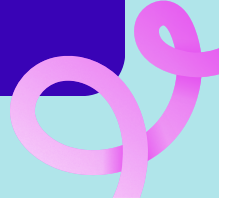

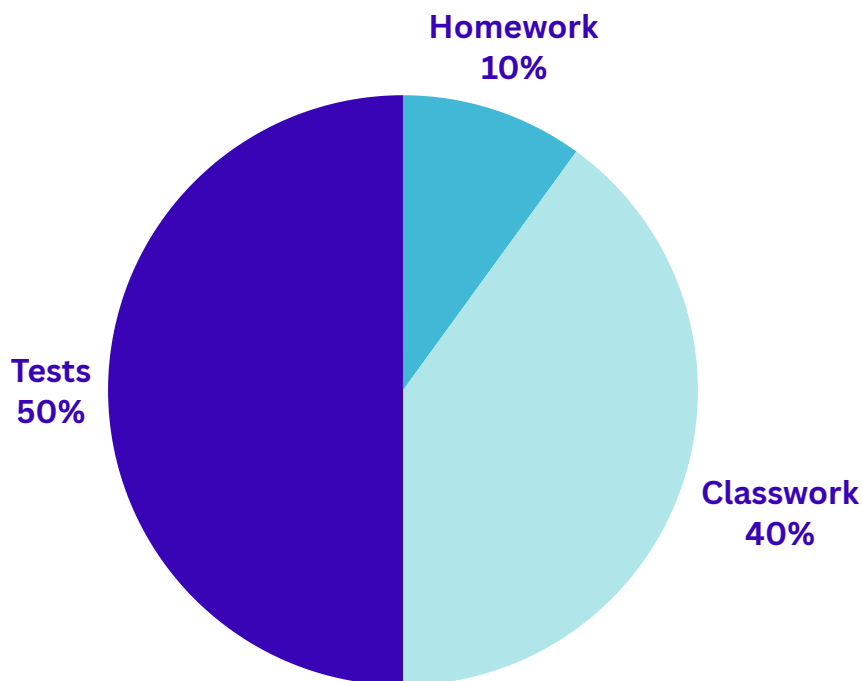
Grading Scale
