3 of the campers started making a fire. 3 more campers walked over to help. How many campers are making a fire now?

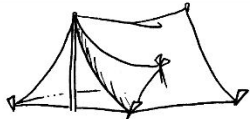
8 campers sang songs by the campfire while 5 campers made smores. How many more campers are singing songs?

There are 3 dirt paths in the woods straight ahead. There is 1 dirt path in the woods to the left. How many dirt paths in the woods are there in all?

There are 4 campers setting up tents and 6 campers looking for firewood. How many campers were at camp in all?

Dan brought 5 sleeping bags to share at camp. One sleeping bag tore on a tree limb on the path to camp. How many sleeping bags does Dan have to share now?
