Dear Mom/Dad/Anyone at home,

The date is \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_. As you are aware, I am leaving home and heading to Canada because there is gold there. I want to make a better life for myself so I will go there to mine gold and hopefully start a family there. I'm currently on a ship heading towards Canada and I am hearing that there are some unfair things that are going to happen to me just because I am Chinese. From the guards, I have heard that I may have to pay a tax, called the Chinese Head Tax just because I am Chinese. I'm not sure why only Chinese people have to pay this tax, but what I'm hearing is that Canadian citizens think that all Chinese people are going to steal their jobs just because they don't have to pay us as much. They also believed that we were going to all be something called sourjourners, which meant that we would bring all the money earned here and take it back to our own country, which is not my plan. I'm not sure why they would think that, because as a Chinese person, I know that I wouldn't be
