# Who am 1? Am I a Raptor? ANSWER SHEET

When identifying a Raptor, think of the 3 Sharps!

Sharp eyesight

Sharp downward curved beak

Sharp talons

What really sets a Raptor apart is the fact that they catch and kill their prey with their feet and sharp talons. Their beak is used to help tear up their meal into smaller pieces – like Raptor cutlery!

All of these birds might be considered 'Birds of Prey' as they all eat prey, but only Depending on the size of the prey, they might even swallow it whole! 4 of them are considered true Raptors.

E Turkey Vulture - I'm not technically a raptor. I only eat dead things! am a scavenger, and clean up the environment. My stomach acid is so strong that I help stop the spread of bacteria just by eating. My beak is very sharp for tearing up meat.

F Great Blue Heron - I may not be a raptor, but I'm very large! You'll probably see me by the water, fishing in the shallows. I also eat a wide variety of other things like reptiles and small mammals. B Cooper's Hawk - I'm a RAPTOR - I'm quick, so you might miss me as I swoop down to catch my prey. Don't underestimate my small size; I have incredible force in my feet. My sharp beak helps me tear up food.
