Dear Division 8 and 9 Parents,

Over the next few weeks, your child will begin taking part in a weekly activity which we are calling **Nature School**. On Tuesday mornings, the students of division 8 and 9 will be spending the first part of the day outside taking part in a variety of activities that are connected with the curriculum. Our intention in doing this is to give children a chance to be outside, connecting with nature, and connecting with the place that they live and go to school.
