

Body Science Crossword Puzzle

Your task, should you choose to accept it (just kidding: you have no choice!), is to create a crossword puzzle using the information you have studied in the “Always Changing” booklet.

Criteria:

- A puzzle grid and a corresponding answer key
- Use of at least 30 of the words from the “Always Changing” glossary in your answers
- Clarity of communication in clues (can be simple or challenging, but must logically lead to the correct answer)
- Follows standard crossword puzzle format:
 - chronological numbering of answers in the grid, from left to right
 - empty spaces blacked out
 - clues listed in order, divided into “Across” and “Down” sections
 - agreement in clues and answers in terms of plural and singular forms, tenses, and abbreviations
- Maturity in approach: humor can be included, but silliness is discouraged
