

Sort 14 Pink Group Explanation

We are continuing to learn about 2 syllable word patterns.

This sort highlights:

2 syllable words with a short vowel sound in the first syllable (VC/V) ex. Never
- we would separate these words after the consonant (nev-er)

Never, river, lemon, finish, wagon, second, visit, planet, seven, present

and

2 syllable words with a long vowel sound in the first syllable (V/CV) ex. Human
- we would separate these words after the vowel (hu-man)

Human, pilot, student, lazy, humour, music, frozen

And

2 syllable words with a long vowel sound in the first syllable created by 2 vowels (VVCV) ex. Reason
-these words would be separated after the 2 vowels (rea-son)

Reason, meeting, leader, easy, sneaker, peanut

There are no oddball words this week. However, minute could be seen as an oddball word as it can be read as mi-nute or min-ute depending on the context.
