Thoughts on Leadership

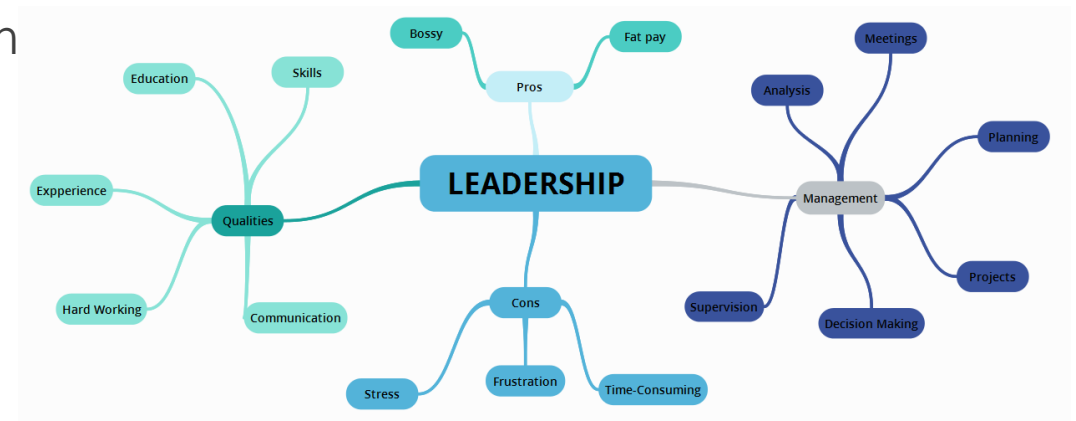
- ▶ **The greatest leader is not necessarily the one who does the greatest things. He is the one that gets the people to do the greatest things.**

 - ▶ Point form or mind map





 - ▶ Problem solving skills



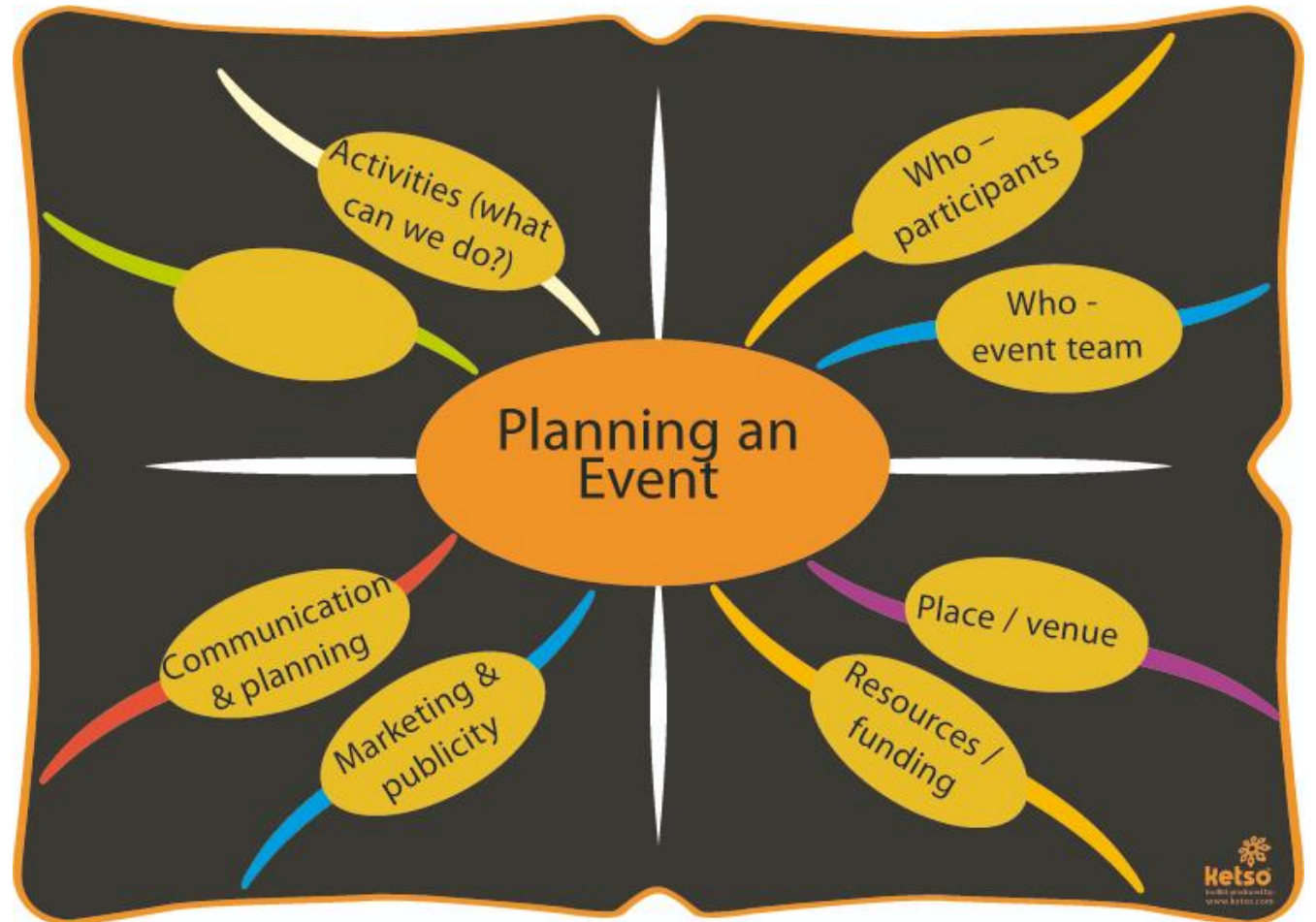
Experience
