LEARNING FRAMEWORK OVERVIEW - POSSIBLE ACTIVITIES

Remember you should be working on <u>SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING and CONNECTIONS</u> for 20 Minutes a day Time, <u>LITERACY</u> for 20 Minutes a day and <u>NUMERACY</u> for 20 Minutes a day and. In addition, you might choose to do some <u>FLEXIBLE LEARNING ACTIVITIES</u> using a timeframe of your choice.

Literacy Time (20 Minutes Daily):

- Grab a book and settle down for some reading (individual, shared reading)
- Kids A-Z Learning website. Your child can work on assignments or select other resources for reading and writing practice.

Numeracy Time (20 Minutes Daily):

- Create patterns, map out your home, measure something, play cards
- Zorbits Math Adventure is a game-based learning program that helps students strengthen their math ability and build a positive attitude towards learning math

Social Emotional Learning and Connections (20 Minutes Daily):

- Weekly Phone call or meeting in Teams
