She needs vases.

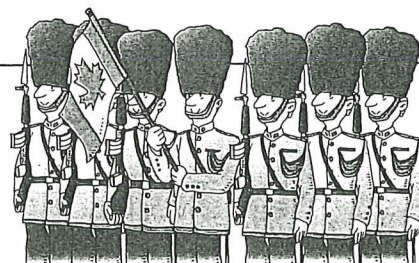
- 55 Tom and Sally share 12 lollipops between them. How many lollipops does each child have?
