604-436-5400 or by coming into the library



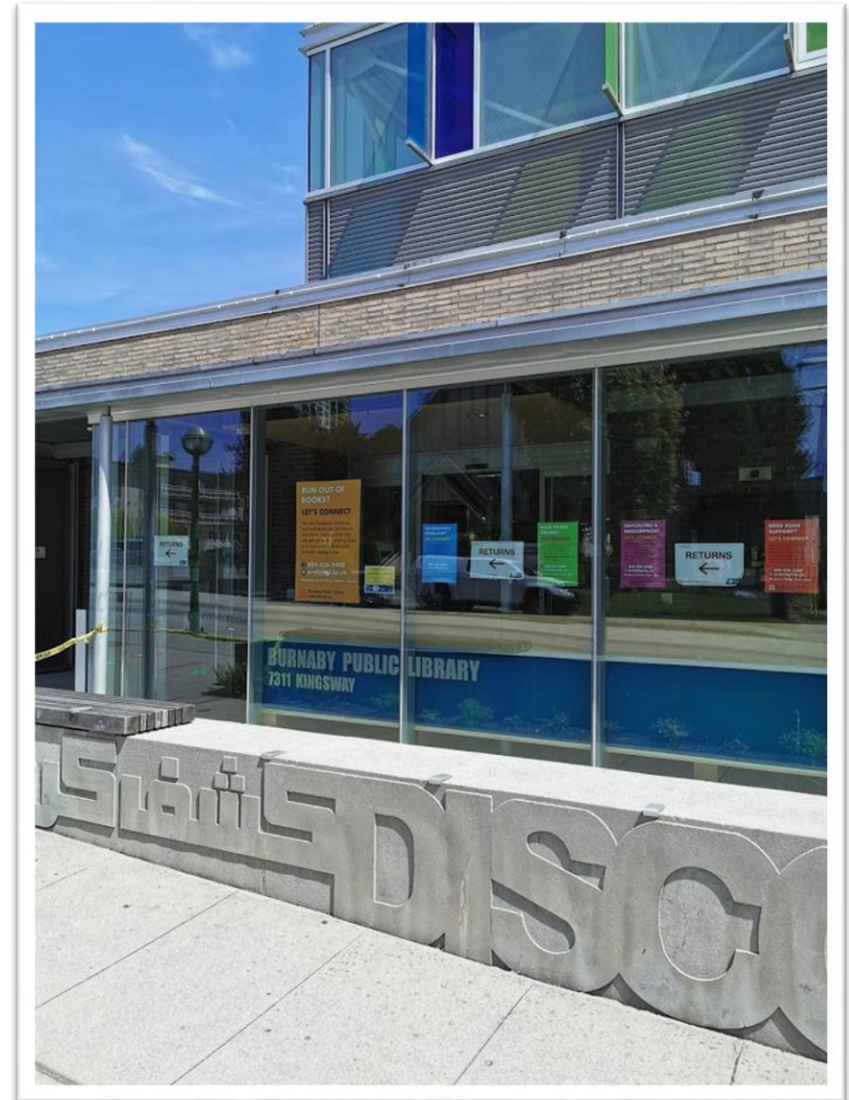
LIMITED REOPENING! IN-BRANCH SERVICES

You will be greeted by someone at the door. You may need to line up, but only if too many people are in the library. Each Burnaby Public Library location looks a little different.

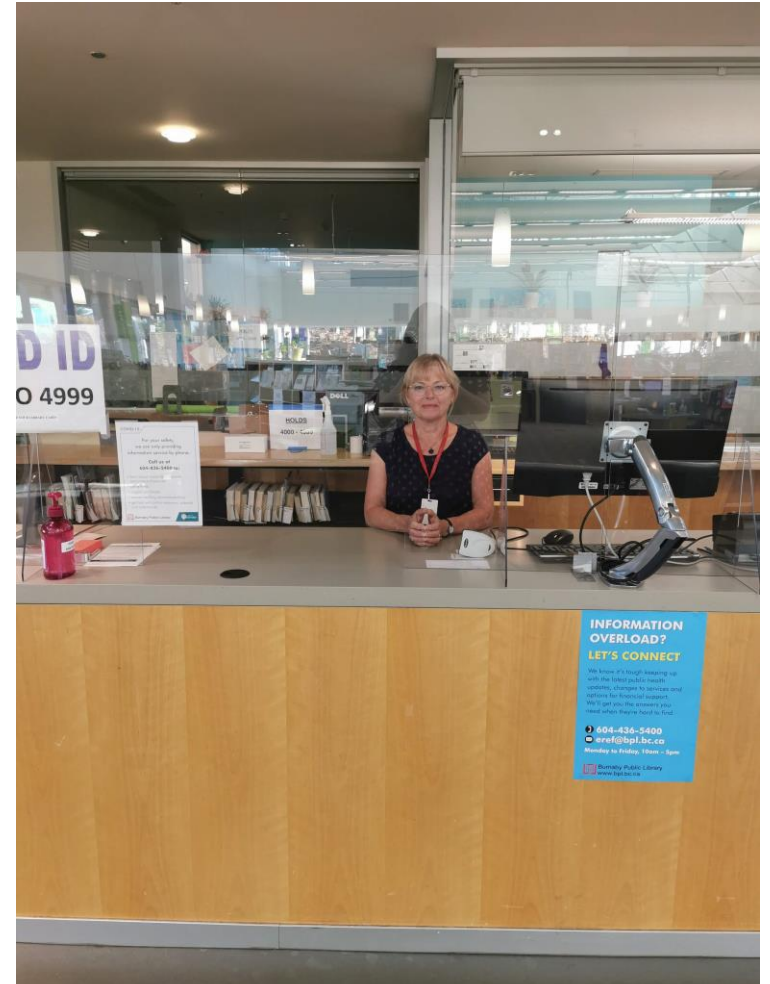




This is where you can pick up your Summer Reading Club Medal!

No registration or proof needed. Just let us know you have been reading

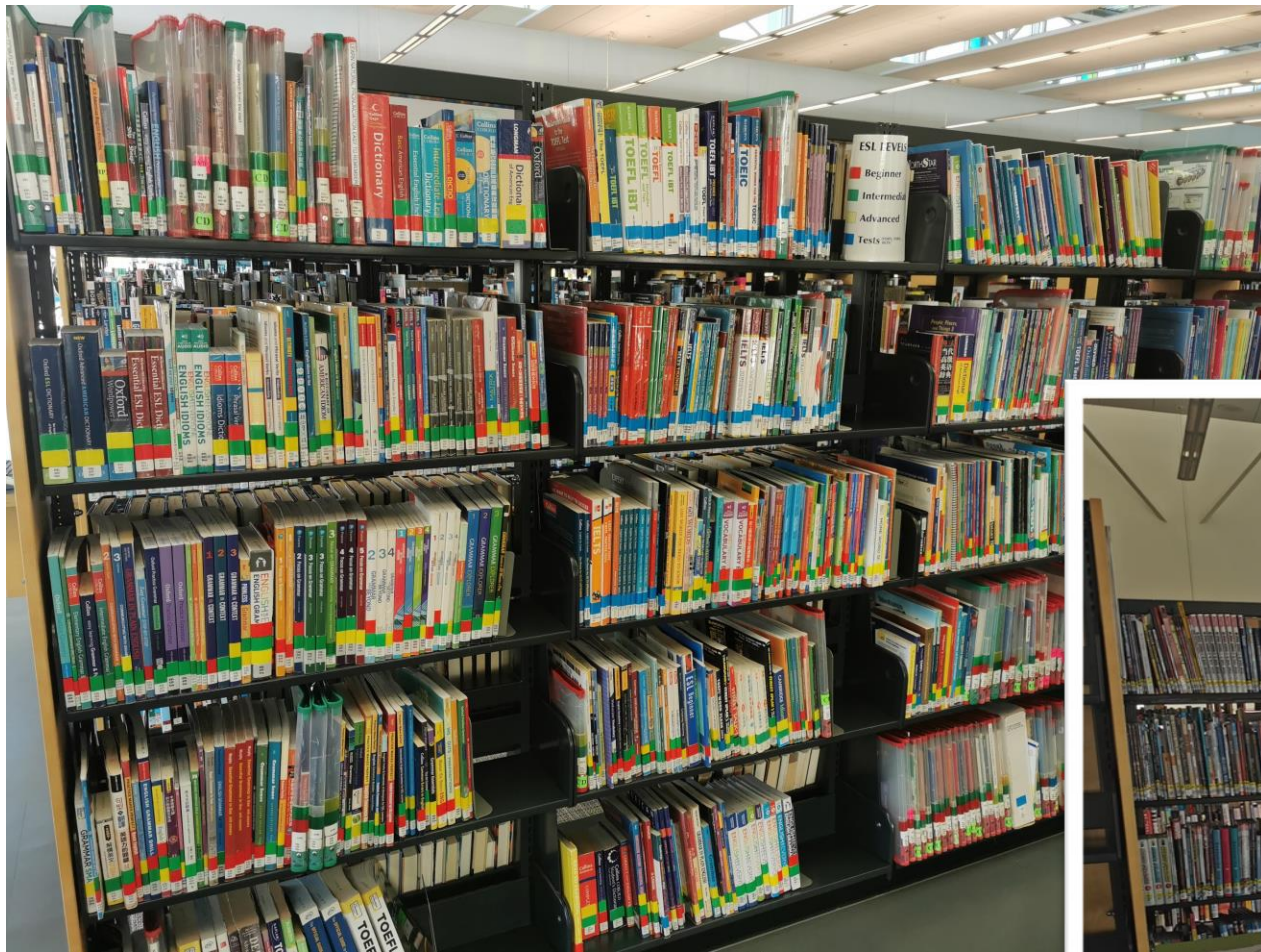




Follow the **red** arrows to checkout books or pick up holds! A staff member will help you.

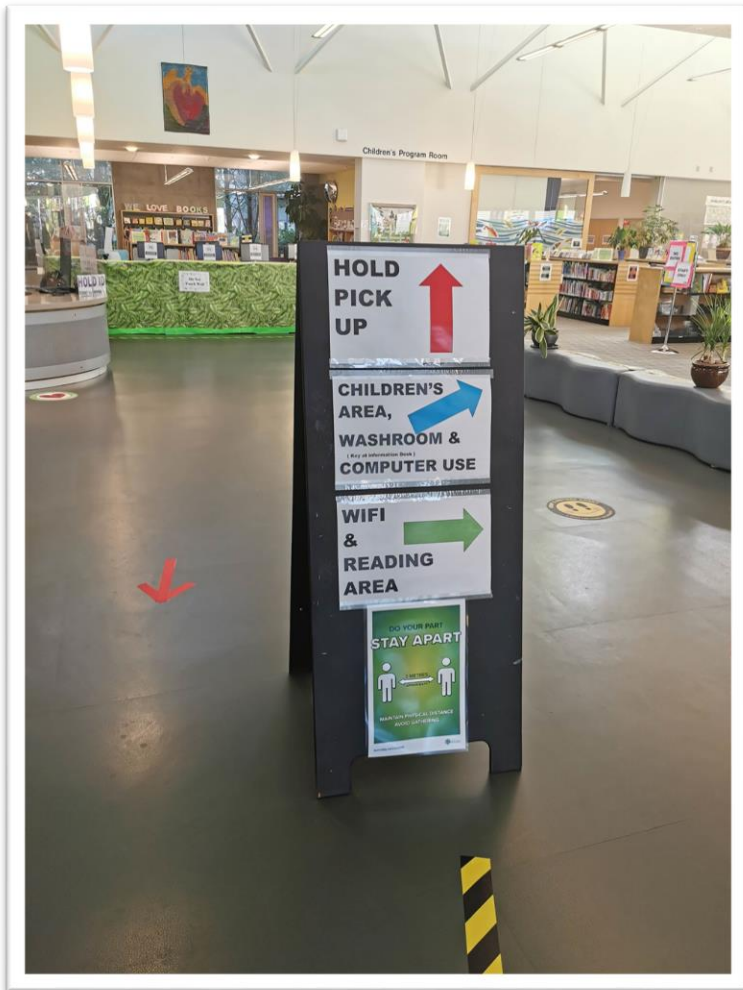


Follow the **green** arrows to go to the Wi-Fi/reading area, adult fiction, adult non-fiction, and teen areas.

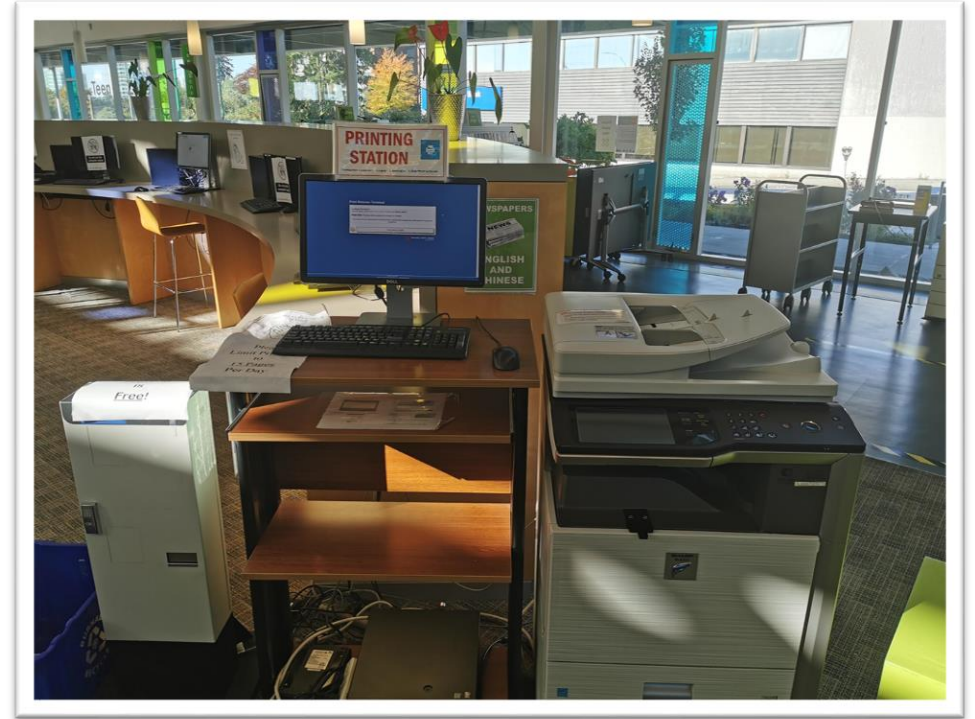


Adult Non-Fiction and
Wi-Fi/Reading areas

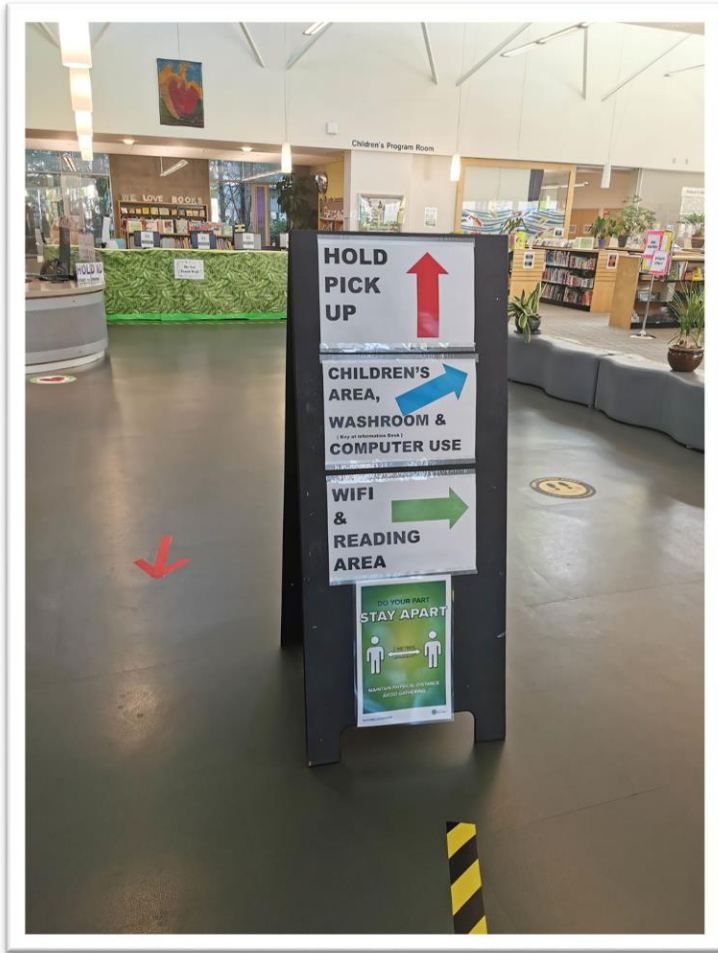




Follow the **Blue** arrows to go to the computers and information desk

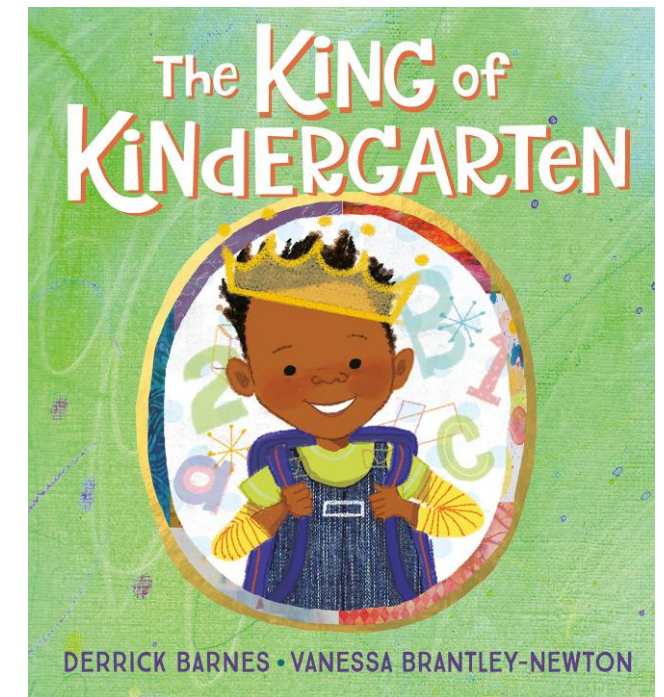
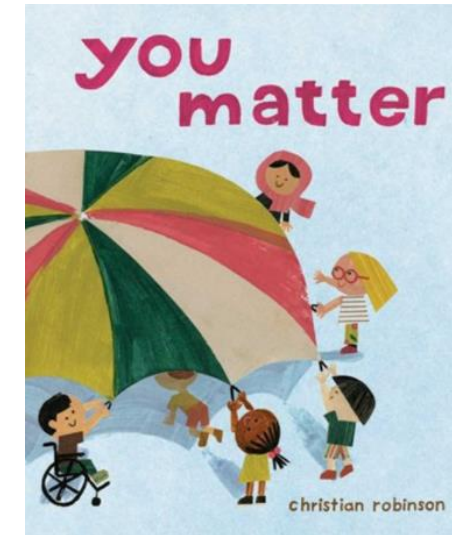
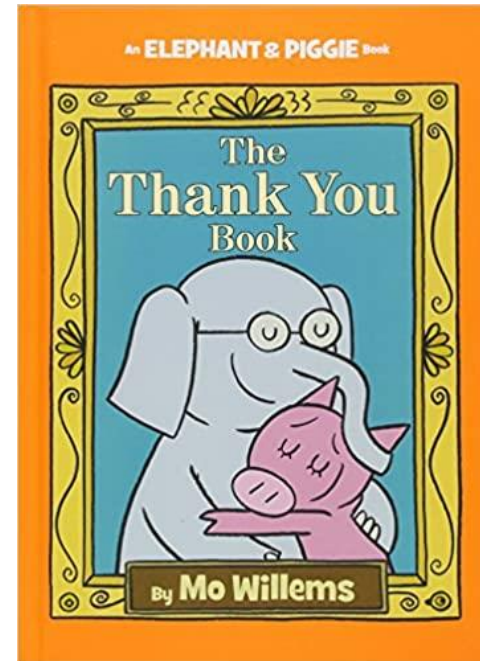
