



## The Pianist- Post Film Assignment/Reflection

Goal: Imagine that you are Wladyslaw (family members, friends, or other Jewish people around him) and have seen your family and countless others killed or taken away for extermination. Would you have the strength to fight for your own survival? Explain.

The categories that will be looked at are: Individual, Context, and Reaction. See assignment handout for breakdown.

Students will also be given a mark out of 5 for their presentation totaling up to 65.
