Rock Monster Colour Project!

This is an integrated project that covers Literacy, Math, Art, and Health and Wellness. You can do bits and pieces throughout the week at the pace that is best for your family.

Read – Draw – Play – Move – Watch – Create – Sort - Share

Read!



Read the *Rock Monsters* book together (link can be found on our class blog).

Draw!



Draw a picture of you with the Rock Monster that you think is helping you the most right now. Include in the picture clues about how the Rock Monster is helping you or what you have been doing.

If you're feeling brave, you can try to s-t-r-e-t-c-h out some words to write down to help tell the story of your picture.

Play!



There are 5 colours of rock monsters! Find 5 objects around your home that match those colours (red, yellow, blue, green, purple). Get a piece of paper and a pencil. With an adult, play a little hiding game:

- Close your eyes! Have the adult hide a few objects under a blanket.
- Open your eyes! Count how many objects are *not* hiding. Use what you know to guess how many are hiding under the blanket.
- For each correct guess you make, you get 1 point. Play until you reach 10 points!
- On your paper, record your score using tally marks. Don't forget that 5 tally marks make a bundle! So your 10 point goal is 2 bundles!

Extra Challenge (optional) – play with 10 objects!!
