**Theme:** Weather and Measurement

If you find yourself wanting some extra tricky jobs, here are some extensions to add to this week's activities!

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### Science Journal



If you have a printer at home, print out the Science Journal page from the class blog to help you keep track of the weather!

### Count! 123

Do two different counting collections – once you have done them, compare your quantities. Ask yourself questions about how they are similar and different:

- Where are they both in relation to 5? More or less?
- Can you fit one inside the other? (ex: 3 and 7 – I can fit two of my 3 counting collections inside my 7 counting collection, and still need one more!)
- When I split them up into different parts, can I have any overlapping quantities? (ex: 3 and 7 – I can split 3 up into 2 plus 1, and I can split 7 up into 2 plus 5)
- What other connections can I make between the two quantities? How are they different?



### Retell!

After reading *Ferdinand the Story Catcher* on Epic!, retell the story! Draw three pictures showing the beginning, middle, and end of the story.

### Measure!



Choose a single measuring item in your home (like a block, a pencil, a toy car, or a book) and see how many things you can measure using that item, just like the ants used themselves to measure the different bugs! (ex: how many pencils long is your bed? Your table? Your shoe? Your brother?) Record your observations using a piece of paper and help from an adult.



### Move!

Invent your own brain break movement activity! Record a video of you doing a dance, stretch, song, or other activity to get your body moving!
