Spring break is a great time to relax, enjoy and **reinforce concepts** learned at school this year. It is a time to revisit: old spelling word lists (in planner), read fiction and non-fiction books (from home or library), practice addition and subtraction skills as well as practice writing down memories and experiences created over the break. Spend time **discussing** concepts with your child. Ask him/her what they are reading about (**ask for details**). Discuss current events or events happening in the family. Discuss and support your child with writing 5 or more sentences using some describing words to make a more interesting, detailed sentence. Stress importance of correct spelling, neatness, starting each sentence with a capital letter and ending each sentence with punctuation. Enjoy your break!
