WHAT IS BATTLE OF THE BOOKS?

Battle of the Books is a reading program and team-based event that encourages both a high quality and a large quantity of reading. The titles on the book list have been chosen to get students to think deeply about different places, time periods, and perspectives. We hope students will be able to find books that are "windows" into the experiences of others and "mirrors" that reflect aspects of their own lives! In a few short weeks, students will demonstrate their knowledge of the books in a "tournament" which is a collaborative and competitive game-show style event.

HOW DOES MY CHILD PARTICIPATE?

Students read as many titles as possible from the book list provided over the course of the next several weeks. As students are reading, they take initiative by writing notes and creating trivia/comprehension questions about the book they are reading. Later on, teams will be challenged to answer as many questions correctly as possible.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

In order to be successful, student should read often! They will be given some time in class to read independently and make notes, but we encourage you to support their reading at home as well. Please help support your child in staying organized and keeping track of their novel and notes! If you have any questions, please reach out to your child's classroom teacher.
