**What to Pack &  
Prepare**



**When  
packing,  
please be  
aware...**

1. Students should be equipped to handle a variety of weather conditions as many activities take place outdoors (rain or shine).
2. We encourage labeling your child's belongings. Use what you already have... we don't want to add extra expense!
3. Pack light... students are responsible for carrying their own backpack/bag

# **Backpack:**

**Students should bring a backpack/daypack with the following items:**

- 1 reusable water bottle**
- 1-2 small snacks**
- A hat or cap**
- Sunscreen (weather dependent)**
- Extra socks**
- 1 book for reading (optional)**
- OPTIONAL: a digital camera or disposable camera**
- An Epipen (if needed)**



# **What to Wear:**

**Students should be dressed in clothing that allows them to be active:**

- Closed-toe shoes (runners, sneakers, or hiking boots)**
- Socks**
- Custom tie-dye t-shirt**
- Sweatpants, leggings, etc.**
- Hoodie or layering piece**
- A rain jacket**
- Sunscreen (weather dependent)**



**We suggest dressing in light layers and checking the weather forecast prior to departure!**

# **A reminder that these items are NOT ALLOWED at Camp:**

- **Cell phones, MP3 players, portable gaming systems, laptops, or other electronic devices**
- **Knives, pocket knives, scissors, or any other sharp objects**
- **Water guns, nerf guns, or any weapons or weapon-like toys**
- **Matches, lighters, or any smoking paraphernalia**
- **Gum**
