


The Story of the Salmon Project:



As we are learning, salmon are crucial to the existence of many organisms, industries, and cultural celebrations in British Columbia. It is important that we understand the complexities of the salmon life cycle so that we can better protect this keystone species.

You will create either a **small poster (11x17 paper)**, a **booklet**, or a **comic** that details the life cycle of a salmon. Your goal is to educate your reader about each stage of the life cycle.

Your project should...

- Include each phase of the salmon life cycle (from the beginning to the end of their lives)
- For each phase, include 2-3 points that describe:
 - When this stage takes place
 - Behaviour of the salmon in this stage
 - Physical attributes/appearance during this stage
- Include a diagram (neatly drawn by hand, coloured using pencil crayons) of each salmon stage
- Include at least 2 reasons that salmon are important to our local and global environment and communities

Using the AI Overview or ChatGPT is not accepted for this project.

Research Phase: (due, to Ms. Ward for approval, by March 13th)

You should prioritize taking notes from reputable and reliable sources. Please make sure your work (good copy) is written in your own words, not copied directly from the sources.
