

Week 2 Housekeeping Items

Hello Students and Parents,

Now that we are finishing up our first official week of Online Learning, I want to fill you in on some changes I've made based on additional information we've received from the School District as well as the Ministry of Education.

Moving forward each week your schedule will look the same as it did this week. However, what will be different is the subjects we do together are now considered **Flexible Tasks**. This will be laid out in a checklist for you to print off to help you keep track of Flexible assignments and tasks for the rest of the term. For the Flexible Subjects you will need to complete a minimum number of assignments in that subject by the end of the term but which assignments those are, and to some degree when they are handed in, is up to you. Please see the checklist for a different way of laying out this information.

The due dates for the assignments in Teams will remain the same. That means if you choose to do units further into the term you will have more time. If you choose to do units earlier in the term you will have less time. However, for assignments in the first 5 weeks of the term I will disregard "lates" up to 7 days past the original "due" date. Also keep in mind all assignment due dates are suggestions to help keep you on track. For the assignments you choose not to do, you can simply upload a Word Document to the assignment saying "This is not one of my chosen assignments", turn it in, and the assignment will disappear for you allowing you to focus on what you are actually doing.

For you to make informed decisions about what units you would like to complete I will be posting the weekly schedules for the remainder of the year instead of week to week as planned. Additionally, if you enjoyed your workload this week, you want to keep busy, or you are interested in all the Flexible Assignments you are more than welcome to complete all the Flexible Assignments each week. These will be considered an extension of your learning for the term.

I know this is a lot of information. I know you likely feel like you receive a lot of information on what feels like a daily basis. I feel the same way, I promise you, and I am working to make this as stable an experience as possible. I ask that you be patient and gracious with me during this incredibly challenging time. I am working very hard and doing my best for all of you.

Re-read this once you've had some time to digest the information, ask me any questions you may have. It is difficult to convey this type of information and these types of changes over text only, what may seem totally clear to me, may be clear as mud to you. I am doing my best to be explicit and clear but each person intakes information differently. If you want to have a chat over the phone to confirm your understanding, I am totally open to that.
