We want all students to practice using Microsoft Teams during the practice assessment dates and times so that they can get comfortable with writing an assessment online. The questions on the practice are not meant to be sample questions for the actual assessment. The start time is there for students who want to experience the timing of the assessment. If you can't get online at the start time, the practice assessments will be available until 10:00 pm on Sunday June 6. The practice assessment will also include the following statement that all students need to agree to before being able to write the actual assessment.

I understand that all the responses that I provide on the ACTUAL Honours entrance assessment will be solely my own. I will not consult other individuals, the internet or any other resources during the testing time. I will be allowed to ask a parent or older sibling to help upload answers (if needed), but they cannot help me answer the questions in any way. Your current Grade 7 teacher(s) may also be provided with a copy of your responses. Failure to adhere to these statements will void my application to enter Grade 8 Honours courses for September 2020 and may also prevent me from applying to future Honours/AP courses at Burnaby South.

Socials 8 Honours	The assessment will have only 1 question.	
	Students will be asked to read a newspaper article and	
	write a response to a prompt.	
Science 8 Honours	The assessment will have 3 questions.	
	Given some written and graphical information, students	
	will be asked to:	
	 draw conclusions from the information provided 	
	 create an experiment using given parameters 	
Math 8 Honours	The assessment will have 5 questions.	
	Students will be asked to write out their solutions	
	showing their work to justify their answer.	
	 Calculators are allowed for this assessment, but 	
	may not be needed for all questions.	
	For this assessment, the upload of student responses	
	can be done using one of three ways:	
	 Installing the Microsoft Teams APP onto a 	
	smartphone, then taking a photo of the math	
	responses and uploading them directly to	
	Microsoft Teams APP on the phone	
	 Using a tablet (an electronic device with a writing 	
	instrument) to write math responses, then saving	
	the file and uploading it to Microsoft Teams	
	 Taking a photo of the math responses and 	
	sending it to Amos.Lee@burnabyschools.ca. A	
	reply confirming receipt of the responses will be	
	sent.
